Judith Marian Wells, 73, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Thursday, March 19, 2026. Her daughter and her niece, Shelly Wright, were there to love and support her as she transitioned home.

Judith was born September 26, 1952, in Topeka, the daughter of Phillip and Lillie Flowers Wells, and grew up in North Topeka, attending Grant Elementary School, Curtis Jr. High, and Topeka High School.
