Justice Terrell Mitchell, 18, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, June 26, 2017.

Justice was born September 13, 1998, in Topeka, the son of Angela Henderson Lee and Mayo Mitchell, Jr. He attended Williams Magnet Elementary School, French Middle School and graduated from Shawnee Heights High School in the spring of this year. Justice was a gifted athlete excelling in football and track. He started playing football when he was five years old and while a student at French Middle School he broke the city record in the 100 meter hurdles. His senior year as a Shawnee Heights Thunderbird, Justice was named an honorable mention all-Centennial League defensive back and also was named all-city honorable mention. He qualified for the State Outdoor Track and Field Meet in Wichita, competing in the 110 meter hurdles, placing eleventh. Justice was to attend Washburn University this fall where he hoped to play football and had aspirations of being an oral surgeon.

Justice volunteered for Reading for Touchdowns, reading with elementary school children, for Young Life and while at Shawnee Heights volunteered his help in many ways. He touched many people in his short life and he will be dearly missed.

Grateful to have shared his life are his mother, Angie Lee; his father, Mayo Mitchell, Jr.; siblings, Steven Mitchell (Tracy), Ashley Mitchell, Jessica Puntty (Michael, Jr.), Brianna Martin, Cody Harrison; his grandmothers, Cheryl Moss and Betty Jean Mitchell; and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephews.

Funeral service for Justice will be Wednesday, July 5, 2017, at 11 a.m. at Love Fellowship Church, 2636 SE Minnesota Ave, Topeka KS 66605. Visitation will be two hours prior to service, from 9 to 11 a.m. Burial will follow in Mount Auburn Cemetery.
