Kathleen Patricia Pfeifer, 78, passed away Thursday, August 4, 2005.

Kathleen was born February 18, 1927 in New York, New York to Charles and Catherine McGrath Murray. Kathleen married William C. Pfeifer on May 23, 1953 in Whitestone Long Island, NY. He survives.
