Kenneth Wayne Fisher, 70, Topeka, passed away unexpectedly Monday, November 24, 2014. Ken was born March 20, 1944, in Ada, Oklahoma, the son of Clifford and Betty Germann Fisher. Ken attended Seaman High School, graduated from Highland Park High and served our country in the Army National Guard. On October 10, 1964, Ken and Barbara Jean Bohl were united in marriage. They celebrated their 50th anniversary last month. Ken worked at By-Lo Grocery as a meat-cutter, owned Ken's Super Saver, worked for food brokers, worked for Laird-Noller Ford and had a hand in many car lots.
