Kenneth Leroy Ranker, Sr. of Topeka, Kansas passed away on December 11, 2024, at the age of 91. He was born on July 23, 1933, in Ellsworth, Kansas to Robert and Susan Ranker.

In school, Ken played football. After graduation, he joined the United States Air Force at the end of the Korean War. Ken built communication towers all over the world, including Greenland and North Africa. In Washington DC, Ken met the love of his life, Della Parker. They married on September 14, 1955, and had two sons and a daughter.

Ken worked as a lineman for Southwestern Bell for many years. His hobbies included spending time with family, meeting his friends for coffee, watching football, playing cards, fishing, and traveling.
