He graduated with honors from Washburn University School of Law, where he served on the Board of Editors for the Washburn Law Journal. Kerry was admitted to the Kansas bar in 1985. He was also admitted to practice before the U.S. District Court of Kansas and the U.S. Court of Appeals, Tenth Circuit. Kerry practiced law in Topeka since 1985, spending time working for the Kansas School Board Association for several years before venturing out to establish his own practice. Most recently, Kerry was passionate about helping his clients improve their financial situations, focusing his practice on Bankruptcy Law since 2010. He enjoyed traveling, history, the outdoors, and spending time with his family, and was a devoted father and grandfather.
