Kyle David Pittsenbarger, 30, Topeka, died Saturday, October 8, 2005.

Kyle was born December 11, 1974, in Thousand Oaks, California, the son of Joyce Ilene Hursh Billings and Clifford Marion Pittsenbarger.

He was a graduate of Washburn Rural High School and Kansas City Kansas Community College with an Associates degree in Fire Science. He completed Emergency Medical Technician at Washburn University and he had completed paramedic school at Coffeyville Community College. His instructor was Kaci Adams. He began his firefighting career as a volunteer with Mission Township Fire Department followed by volunteering with Kensington, Maryland Fire Department. He was employed by the Topeka Fire Department assigned to Engine #1. He was a member of the International Association of Firefighters, local 83.
