Laine Ellyn Neff Tangeman, 62, Topeka, passed away Tuesday, April 5, 2016, at the House at Midland Care, surrounded by her family.

Laine was born on July 29, 1953, in Axtell KS, the daughter of Wayne and Mildred Bergman Neff. Laine grew up in Seneca, where she graduated from Saints Peter and Paul Catholic High School in 1971. She then went on to attend Patricia Stevens Career College in Wichita, for fashion merchandising. Laine and Richard H. Tangeman were united in marriage on November 18, 1972, at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Seneca. They enjoyed 43 wonderful years together. Laine was a manager and buyer for Rosie's Show-Off, as well as a director and senior director for Mary Kay Cosmetics, earning four Mary Kay cars during her career.
