Larry R. Spielman, 65, Topeka passed away at home on June 3, 2010 after a courageous battle with brain cancer. He was born on October 12, 1944 in Axtell Kansas to Leo and Clara Kramer Spielman. He grew up on the family farm southeast of Baileyville and graduated from Baileyville High School in 1964. After high school he served in the United States Air Force.
