Larry Franklin Wilson, 51, Topeka, died Saturday, Feb. 14, 2004 in Topeka.

He was born August 11, 1952 in Council Grove, the son of Dale and Lahoma Kahle Wilson. On July 28, 1977, Larry and Alana LoCurto were married in Oahu, Hawaii and five years later had their marriage blessed at St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Perry.

Mr. Wilson had been a farmer, dairyman, worked at the Lawrence Paper Company, and Meadow Gold Dairy. For the last 16 years Mr. Wilson worked for USD #501 Service Center and received the Distinguished Staff Award in 2000. He served in the National Guard from 1971- 1977. He was an assistant Scout Master in BSA, Troop 46 from 1995- 2001. Mr. Wilson was a member of the Knights of Columbus, Council No. 4254. Some of his many hobbies were hunting, cutting firewood and trimming trees.

Survivors include his wife, Alana Wilson, Topeka, daughter, Heather Winzer, Pittsburg, KS; son, Heath Wilson, Topeka; his parents Dale and Lahoma Wilson, Oskaloosa; brother, Jerry Wilson, Eudora; sister, Reta Kitterman, McLouth; grandson, Jack Winzer, Pittsburg; four nieces and one nephew.

Mr. Wilson will lie in state at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home on Tuesday from 3 until 8. A parish rosary will be recited at 6 with family visitation

following. Mass of Resurrection will be celebrated at 11:30 Wednesday at Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church with burial at Eskridge Cemetery at 4 p.m.
