LaVern Hossle Hall, 85, Topeka, passed away Wednesday, July 12, 2006.

LaVern was born March 5, 1921 in Red Oak, Iowa, the daughter of Robert and Myrtle Sellergren Hossle. She graduated from Red Oak High School and the University of Nebraska. In 1945, LaVern and Lloyd Hall were married. They later divorced. She worked in Denver as a medical technologist during WWII. LaVern worked for the blood bank, for Drs. Foster and Kim and Roche Biomedical Laboratory for a total of 17 years. She retired in 1983. She was a Girl Scout leader, a library volunteer, played in numerous bridge clubs, and was an avid traveler.
