



Lawrence "Larry" Domme

July 13, 1917 - September 18, 2003

Lawrence Alexander Domme, 86, Topeka, died Thursday, Sept. 18, 2003. He was born July 13, 1917, to Lawrence Domme and Elizabeth Gibler in Topeka. Mr. Domme was a machinist for the Atchison and Topeka Santa Fe Railway for 42 years. He also owned Domme Liquor Store for 47 years. Mr. Domme was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, 4th Degree Knights of Columbus Council No. 534 and Moose Lodge of Topeka. He married Magdalen Herman in 1940 at St. Joseph Catholic Church. She survives. Other survivors include a daughter, Patricia Martin, Topeka; a son, Larry Domme, Topeka; a brother, Robert Domme, Topeka; five Grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren. Mr. Domme will lie in state from 1 to 5 p.m. Sunday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, where a Daughters of Isabella rosary will be at 3:30 p.m. and a parish rosary will be at 4 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1:30 p.m. Monday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church.
