



## Lawrence "Larry" Noller

Lawrence "Larry" H. Noller, age 81, died Tuesday, October 26, 2004. Born in McFarland, KS, he was a life long resident of Topeka, KS. He was the son of George J. and Margaret Wertzberger Noller. His parents and brother George, preceded him in death.

Mr. Noller was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church and Knights of Columbus Council #8411. He graduated from Capital Catholic High School in 1941, and attended Kansas State University prior to enlisting in the Air Force. He served as a pilot during World War II.

He owned and operated Noller Electric Co. until 1978, and Noller Real Estate until he retired in 1985. He was one of the organizers of Southwest Bank and Trust at 17th and Gage and served as a director from 1962 until 1991. He was instrumental in the development of the Seabrook Center in Topeka, and Pomona Heights Subdivision in Osage County. He had owned pasture land in Chase and Wabaunsee counties. He enjoyed hunting and fishing.

He was married to Charlotte V. Kalina from April 18, 1944 until her death on April 6, 1979. He married Maxine Gossett Emerson on October 4, 1980 at St. John the Evangelist Church in Lawrence, KS. She survives.
