Lee R. Schreiner, 87, Topeka, Kansas, died February 5, 2021. Lee was born during the Great Depression on April 21, 1933, in St. Peter, Kansas, to Lawrence and Mary F. Wasinger Schreiner. They were descendants of the Volga Germans who emigrated to America from Russia.

Lee was a successful self-employed General Contractor, Schreiner Brothers Construction Company, for over 50 years. He served in the Army National Guard. Lee married Jean Nelson on February 12, 1955, at Assumption Catholic Church.

Lee's wife, Jean, preceded him in death in 2013. He was also preceded in death by his parents, siblings, granddaughter, Tyla Snyder, great-grandson, Logan Snyder, and son-in-law, Bruce Snyder.

Lee's survivors are Ramona Snyder, Christine Neal (Paul), Tina Schreiner, Mark Schreiner (Cynthia); grandchildren, Cody Snyder, Casey Snyder, Clint Neal and Katie Shepherd; great-grandchildren, Ava Shepherd, Liam Shepherd and Kayla Snyder.

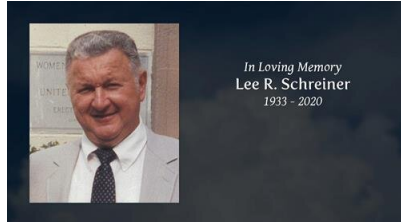
