Leland D. Farlow, 84, Maple Hill, passed away March 2, 2013, at Midland Hospice House, after a long battle with cancer. He was born March 16, 1928, at Home City, Marshall County, Kansas, the son of Leslie C. and Lelia Mae (Chapman) Farlow. Leland graduated from Barneston High School, Barneston NE, in 1946. He served as a Medic in the U. S. Army in Korea in 1951 and 1952. Leland married Anna Lee Rothmier at Purcell, Kansas, on March 15, 1951. She survives. He was preceded in death by a grandson, Chris Chisham and sister, Darlene Smyser. Leland was a lifelong livestock dealer and a partner in the Wakarusalivestock sale barn for many years.
