Master Sgt. (Ret.) Lloyd Huber, 86, Topeka, passed away Saturday, April 2, 2016, surrounded by his loving family.

Lloyd was born January 4, 1930, in Concordia to Milo and Sylvia Neptune Huber. He graduated from Concordia High School in 1947 and married his high school sweetheart Doris Minard in 1950. Lloyd joined the United States Air Force in 1951, serving for 21 years, including service in the Korean War.
