



Lloyd D. Hull

February 22, 1949 - October 7, 2015

Lloyd Dean Hull, 66, Topeka, passed away October 7, 2015, at his home.

Lloyd was born February 22, 1949, in Great Bend, Kansas, the son of Chester and Sybil (Noe) Hull. He earned his BS in Political Science from Sterling College, his Master's degree in Public Administration from the University of Kansas and his Juris Doctorate from the Washburn University School of Law.

Lloyd always had a strong involvement in politics beginning with his volunteering in 1968 for Bobby Kennedy's campaign. Lloyd was waiting outside the hotel for Sen. Kennedy to exit when it was announced that he had been assassinated. Lloyd was involved with the Shawnee County Democrats including service as Chair.

Lloyd worked for Methodist Youthville in Dodge City, Kansas and as a social worker in McPherson for Social and Rehabilitation Services. After earning his law degree he served as a Governor's Fellow in 1985 under John Carlin. In 1986, Lloyd was employed by SRS Central Office in Topeka as a staff attorney until his retirement in 2010. Following retirement, Lloyd briefly worked for Valeo Behavioral Services.

While living in Dodge City, Lloyd was involved in community theater. He was a lifelong reader and bibliophile, particularly of science fiction, the works of

Robert Heinlein most of all.

Survivors include Lloyd's sons, Matt and John Hull; and former wives, Carolyn Hull and Dee Hull. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Patrick Hull.

A Memorial Service will be at 2 p.m. Friday, October 16, 2015, at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614.

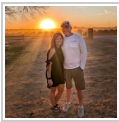
