Lloyd Eugene Sober, 77, Topeka, Kansas passed away on Saturday, January 29, 2022.

Lloyd was born December 30, 1944, the son of Glenn and Lois Bailey Sober, in Leechburg, Pennsylvania. He graduated from Leechburg High School in 1964. Lloyd served in the Air National Guard.
