Lois M. Conroy, 85, died Saturday, June 5, 2004 at a Topeka retirement center.

Mrs. Conroy was born December 24, 1918 in Hartford, KS to Leo and Bessie Farmer Hazlett.

Mrs. Conroy attended Kansas State Teachers College in Emporia, school teacher active in 4-H, and was instrumental in beginning the Sunflower Coets Drum Corps. She was an avid quilter and enjoyed many kinds of crafts.

On February 8, 1941 she married Donald C. Conroy, Sr. He survives. They owned and operated the 7-C motel in Topeka.
