



## Lois Uhl

April 20, 1923 - March 27, 2004

Lois Bernice Uhl 80, Carbondale, died Saturday, March 27, 2004, at Midland Hospice House. This allowed her to be with her departed husband on their 60th wedding anniversary, March 28th.

She was born April 20, 1923 in Topeka, the daughter of Herbert and Gertrude Kreipe Hall.

Mrs. Uhl was a graduate of Highland Park High School and in 1944 graduated from St. Francis School of Nursing, Leavenworth, as a registered nurse. On March 28, 1944, Lois and Bernard B. Uhl were married in Leavenworth. She worked at Memorial Hospital in Topeka from 1973 until she retired in 1988. Mr. Uhl died Nov. 24, 2002.

Mr. and Mrs. Uhl had two sets of twin boys having 5 boys under the age of 4. Five years later they welcomed a baby girl. Survivors include her sons, Doug Uhl and his wife, Rosie, Wakarusa, Steve Uhl and his wife, Linda, Berryton, Mike Uhl and his wife, Penny, Topeka, and Howard Uhl and his wife, Debe, Topeka; her daughter, Bernardene Pressgrove and her husband Mike, Spring Hill; 11 grandchildren and five great grandchildren. A son, Harley Uhl, died January 13, 1986.
