Lorene Lilley Neaderhiser, 100 years, 11 months and 24 days, passed away Saturday, September 15, 2018, in Topeka, Kansas.

Lorene was born September 22, 1917, on a farm four miles east of Longford, Kansas, the daughter of Jesse and Mabel Malcolm Lilley. As she grew up the Longford Church was an important part of her life and she became involved on all levels as Sunday School secretary, children's Sunday School teacher and youth president. This work continued for over 60 years. The church always had an important place in her heart.

On August 18, 1937, Lorene and Raymond Neaderhiser were married in her parents' home. They eventually bought a farm just east of Manchester and lived there for 35 years. In 1975 they bought an RV and enjoyed traveling as farm work permitted. They moved to Abilene in 1990 and Raymond passed away on May 26, 1992.

Lorene joined the Emmanuel Church in Abilene when the church she belonged to in Manchester since 1945 closed. She helped at the church, enjoyed quilting, was a member of the Dickinson County Extension, Flora and Cheever units and Senior Citizens at Industry, Kansas.

Grateful to have shared Lorene's life are her brothers, Edward Lilley (Bessie)

of Clay Center and Kenneth Lilley (Dorothy) of Silver Lake; and many nieces and nephews.

Funeral service will be Friday at 2 p.m. at Emmanuel Church, 1300 N Vine Street, Abilene, Kansas 67410. Family will greet friends one hour prior to the service. Burial will follow in Keystone Cemetery.
