Louise Bernadine (Toodie) Salsbury, Topeka, passed away March 1, 2015.

Toodie was born January 30, 1920, in Burlington KS, the daughter of Joseph M. and Myrtle Clegg Jauernig. She graduated from Burlington High School. On February 5, 1940, she married Ernest (Jim) Salsbury. He preceded her in death in 1987.
