Frank Marcus “Marc” Sabatini, 65, Topeka, Kansas, passed away surrounded by family Wednesday, March 3, 2021.

Marc was born September 23, 1955, in Lawrence, Kansas, to Frank and Alice Chandler Sabatini. He attended Holy Name and St. Matthew Grade Schools and Shawnee Heights High School before attending Savior of the World Seminary in Kansas City, Kansas. Mark attended Pittsburg State University. He loved learning and especially enjoyed Art and Psychology classes.

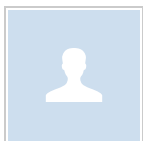

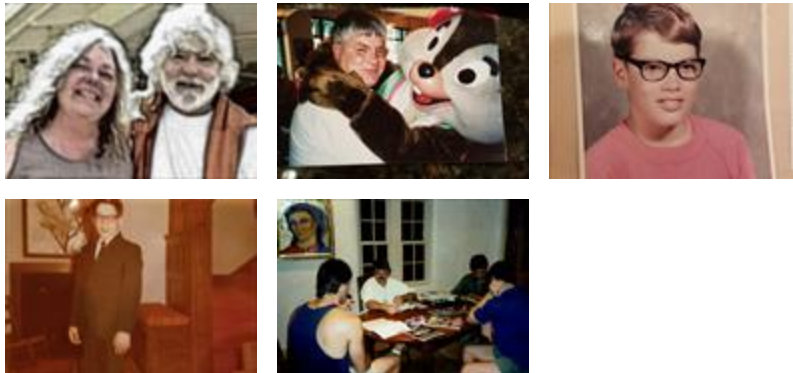
