



## Marcia Diane Wittman

Marcia Diane Peters Wittman, 72, Topeka, passed away Monday, October 17, 2016, at the House at Midland Care.

Marcia was born March 27, 1944, in Smith Center KS, the only child of Eugene and Belva Erdman Peters. She spent her early years on her parents' farm where she began her love of animals, especially her horse, Silver. Marcia attended Most Pure Heart of Mary Grade School and graduated from Hayden High School in 1962. Marcia and Gerald Wittman were united in marriage in 1964 and to this union two sons were born. They later divorced.
