Margaret Heaney Burr passed away at King City, Missouri on June 6, 2012 at the age of 94. She was born in Towner, Colorado on April 29, 1918. She was the daughter of Arthur Joseph Heaney and Anna Biggs Heaney of Emporia, Kansas and points west. She graduated from the University of Missouri at Kansas City in 1960 with a Bachelors Degree in Sociology. She moved to and was a social worker in Garden City, Kansas and the surrounding county. She moved to Memphis, Tennessee in 1970 and lived with her daughter Helen for 22 years as a homemaker and was involved again with social work and literacy programs. She moved back to Kansas (Topeka) in 1992 and then to Missouri in 2004.
