Margaret K. Corbet, Topeka, passed away Thursday, March 5, 2015.

Margaret's family came from Ireland to Kansas in the 1860s and settled in the area near Dover. She was born October 24, 1925, in Topeka, the daughter of Daniel and Katherine Cummings Harmon and graduated from Dover High School and Clark's School of Business. On July 24, 1945, Margaret and Kenneth R. Corbet were united in marriage. He died March 28, 1980.

Margaret was a founding member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church. She was a life-long Democrat, working for the party on numerous campaigns, however she did support one Republican. She also worked at the VA Medical Center and was a buyer and sales associate for Mary Cummings Women's Apparel, Clara's and Turtlenest. She was a member of the Mulvane Art Center Board for many years.

Margaret has a son, Ken Corbet (Beverly) and their children, Justin and Kenny; and her daughter, Debe Uhl (Howard) and their children, Leslie Duncan (Jeff) and Ryan. Margaret's parents, two brothers and two sisters preceded her in death.
