Margaret Hund, 87, Paxico, passed away Tuesday, May 7, 2013. Margaret was born, May 26, 1925, in Lucas KS, the daughter of Joe and Katherine Baur. While quite young, Margaret's family moved to Wilson KS, graduating from high school in 1944. After attending Fort Hays State, Margaret taught at various country schools near Wilson. She attended K-State and graduated from Marymount College in Salina, with a degree in Home Economics. Margaret taught Home Ec. at Marquette for two years and then completed her degree as a Dietician after serving an internship at St. Mary Hospital/Mayo Clinic in Rochester MN. She was employed by St. Joseph Hospital in Hays and Wesley Hospital in Wichita. Deciding that her passion was teaching, she taught for a year at WaKeeney. In 1955, Margaret and Wilfred Hund were united in marriage and settled on the farm in Paxico where they raised their eight children. Wilfred preceded her in death in 1982. Margaret was a wonderful homemaker and loving mother. Being raised in a Czechoslovakian community, she loved baking bread, especially kolaches. Survivors include her children, Fr. Francis Hund, Leawood, Cathryn Radiel (Chris), Olathe, Paul Hund (Lise), Topeka, George Hund (Marcia), Paxico, Ruth Jones (Don), Lyndon, Barbara Leiszler (John), Clifton, Regina Carlin (Willis), Colwich, Julia Brown (Dave), Olathe; 25 grandchildren and one great-granddaughter. Margaret was also preceded in death by her siblings, Francis and Mary Ann Baur.
