



## Margaret Krivjansky

December 15, 1932 - July 23, 2018

Margaret Lucille “Marge” Krivjansky, 85, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, July 23, 2018, at Plaza West Regional Health Center.

Marge was born on December 15, 1932, in East Chicago, Indiana, to Davorin and Margaret Justinich Duimich. She attended Washburn University. Marge worked for Security Benefit Group in the Human Resources Department.
