January 6, 1919 - August 28, 2008

Margaret Ruth Conner Owens, 89, died Thursday, August 28, 2008, at a Topeka nursing home. Margaret was born January 6, 1919, in Circleville, KS, the daughter of Roy William "Pete" Conner and Manta Amelia McCurdy Conner. Margaret married Edward L. Owens on December 11, 1942, in West Palm Beach, Florida. Margaret and Edward lived in Topeka since 1955. Mr. Owens passed away December 7, 2004. Margaret is survived by a daughter, Pauline "Polly" Coulter and her husband Racy Coulter, Topeka; two sons, Thomas "Tom" R. Owens and his wife, Martha "Marty" Owens, Topeka and Mark E.
