



Maria Hiszczynskyj

July 17, 1910 - October 6, 2006

Maria Irene Hiszczynskyj, 96, Topeka, passed away Oct. 3, 2006 at Presbyterian Manor. Her parents were Andrew Tuziak and Antonina Zachkowych. She was born in Ushkowychi, Ukraine on July 17, 1910 and grew up and was educated in Korosno, Ukraine. She married Eustachy (Stan) Hiszczynskyj in Peremyslany, Ukraine on June 16, 1932, who was a widower at the time with two boys. She is survived by sons, Dr. Roman Hiszczynskyj and his wife (Sherry) Elaine of Topeka, Lubon Hiszczynskyj and his wife, Daria, of Fort Dodge, Iowa; stepson, Stefan Hishynsky of Cleveland, Ohio; six grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, four step-grandchildren, and three step-great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Eustachy, of 37 years in 1969; infant son Mirko (Miroslaw) Hiszczynskyj; stepson, Antony Hiszczynskyj; and five brothers. Maria Hiszczynskyj belonged to a Ukrainian choir and taught singing and dancing in Ukraine. She left Ukraine in 1944 and lived in Germany and Austria before coming to the United States in 1949 and settling in Livermore, Iowa and later Fort Dodge, Iowa where she worked as a seamstress. After retirement she moved to Phoenix, Arizona in 1972 where she was active in the Ukrainian Catholic Church and choir. She moved to Topeka in 1995. Maria was a devoted and loving mother. She was a very hard worker and a devout religious person. Her passion was sewing and music and she had a great love for family, her homeland of Ukraine and America.
