Marie Wiebler, 87, Scranton, passed away March 24, 2015.

Marie was born September 13, 1927, to Dale and Esther Edwards in Stockport IA. In November 1946 she was married to Edward Wiebler in Fort Madison IA. They lived in the Fort Madison area raising their family until the spring of 1962 when they moved to Topeka KS. In 1974 the family moved to the farm near Scranton. Marie worked over 30 years in phone companies and retired in 1986 from Southwestern Bell. She was a member of the Southwestern Bell Pioneers, and was recognized for her role in many fundraising campaigns for the United Way while employed with Bell.

Marie is survived by children, Nancy Dayton (Kevin) of Choctaw OK, Janet Reid (Randy) of Prosser WA, David Wiebler (Laura) of Overbrook and Michael Wiebler (Carol) of Topeka.
