Mark Anthony Martinek March 20, 1952-January 10, 2012 After a brave three and a half year battle with cancer, Mark passed away peacefully Tuesday morning amongst family, in the care of Midland Hospice. Mark was born and raised in Topeka, attended Holy Name Grade School, and graduated from Hayden High School in 1971. Upon graduating from high school, Mark went to work for his father, Clarence, in the siding business. Through hard work and dedication to his family and to the trade, Mark became owner of the family business, Mark Martinek Siding. In 1991, the company had grown significantly, and was incorporated as Martinek and Flynn, Inc. Mark was one of six children born to Clarence and Betty Martinek and the beloved husband of Cindy Martinek for 31 years. Mark had a larger-than-life personality, and was the type of person who always put others before himself. Just like his pyrotechnics, Mark was full of energy and life. He worked hard, lived big and loved immensely, to the end. He was preceded in death by his brother, Dan Martinek, and his sister, Cindy Scott, and will forever be remembered by his dear wife, Cindy; beloved children, Brett Martinek with his fiancé Kristen Stueve and daughter Taylor, Cody Martinek and Nikki Martinek; devoted brother, Darrell Martinek (Brenda); loving sisters, Deb Flynn (Rick) and Tina Hunter (Shane); and beloved brother-in-law, Glenn Scott; along with innumerable other family and friends, who were blessed to have known him. Family will greet friends from 5 to 7 p.m. Thursday, January 12, followed by a prayer service and special remembrances with Mark's eulogy at Mater Dei

Holy Name Catholic Church, 1114 SW 10th Street. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at the Church. Inurnment will follow at Mount Calvary Cemetery.
