Mark Evan Stubbs, 67, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Sunday, June 26, 2022.

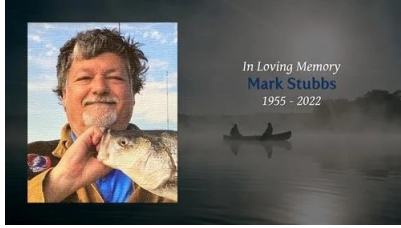
