Marshall Douglas Gould, 36, Topeka, Kansas, passed away unexpectedly of natural causes Monday, December 24, 2018.

Marshall was born December 27, 1981, in Topeka, the son of Douglas and Connie Shaffer Gould. He graduated in 2000 from Highland Park High School where he played football, baseball and wrestled. 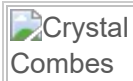
