Mary Ann Hall, 77, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Tuesday, February 25, 2020.

Mary Ann was born to Henry and Regina Orchlin Weishaar, October 2, 1942, in an Atchison hospital but lived in Nortonville, Kansas.

Mary Ann attended St. Joseph Catholic Grade School, graduating from Nortonville High School.
