August 15, 1933 - March 17, 2021

Mary Frances Mott Bueltel, 88, Topeka, Kansas died March 17, 2021, with her children by her side.

Mary was born August 15, 1933, in Strong City, Kansas. She was the fifth of eleven children born to Jesse Loren and Florence Cecelia Peschel Mott.

After high school, Mary met the love of her life, John Robert "Bob" Bueltel on a blind date. They married on January 15, 1955, and the couple enjoyed sixty-five years together. They had the opportunity to tour the world. On one of their adventurous travels to the Holy Land, they took time to renew their wedding vows.

The couple had two children, Linda (Rick) Bull and John (Danita) Bueltel.

Mary would do anything for friends and family. Volunteering, cooking for

families, sewing, hosting gatherings, attending all games, recitals, school plays all while running her own business; she was there for it all. Mary did not know how to say no.

Mary was preceded in death by her husband, Bob who passed just nine months prior on June 13, 2020. She is survived by her children, Linda and John; grandchildren, Ben, Ian, Heather, Brandon, Sara, Brady, Mykel, Dalton; and great-grandchildren, Preston and Payton.
