Mary Ann Heit, 80, Raymore, Missouri, passed away on November 20, 2019, in Topeka, Kansas.

Mary was born in Kinsley, Kansas on August 16, 1939, to Joseph and Augusta (Pfeifer) Heit. The family moved to Topeka where she attended St. Joseph Grade School, graduated from Hayden Catholic High School in 1957, and attended Washburn University.

Mary worked for American Home Life Insurance for over 40 years before becoming an independent insurance agent in 2001. That career took her to Arroyo and Monterey, California, which she thoroughly enjoyed, before settling in Raymore, Missouri in 2012. In her spare time, Mary enjoyed knitting, cross-stitching, and visiting with people everywhere she went, especially while volunteering at St. Joseph Medical Center in Kansas City.

Mary is survived by three brothers, James, Francis, and Bernard Heit; and several nieces and nephews.

Mary's wishes were to be cremated.
