Mary Jo Waugh, 69, of Topeka, passed away peacefully at her home on Friday, December 9, 2016, comforted with love and surrounded by her family.

Mary Jo was born October 5, 1947, in Topeka KS to Joseph and Florence (Mock) Walsh. She graduated from Hayden High School in 1965, where she later served on the Reunion Committee. After attending Washburn University, she worked for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas and retired after 36 ½ years as Regional Sales Manager. After retirement, she dedicated her time to her family and was strongly committed to volunteerism. She served as either a Board Member or had committee affiliation with many organizations including the Greater Topeka Chamber of Commerce, Sales & Marketing Executives of Topeka, Easter Seals Capper Foundation, Meals on Wheels, Kansas Blue Cross Blue Shield Credit Union, Kansas Health Insurance Association, Go Red for Women, and United Way Greater Topeka. She was also a proud member of Christ the King Catholic Church.
