Mary Louise Finan, 90, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Friday, January 19, 2018.

Mary Lou was born July 14, 1927, near Wheaton, Kansas, the daughter of James and Margaret Higgins Keating. She graduated from Blaine Rural High School in 1945, St. Francis School of Nursing in 1948 and was an RN in the U S. Cadet Nurse Corps. On September 2, 1950, Mary Lou married Thomas Finan in St. Columbkille's Church in Blaine. He preceded her in death on April 6, 2004.

Mary Lou was a school nurse for over 30 years at Holy Name School (Mater Dei School) and USD 501 schools. She was a member of Mater Dei Holy Name Church for more than 60 years. She volunteered in her parish, at the VA Hospital, St. Francis Hospital and the American Red Cross where she received the Jan Ogan Distinguished Nurse Award in 2000.
