Mary Lucile Neider, 91, formerly of Topeka, passed away Tuesday, June 21, 2016, in Windom KS.

Luci was born on October 28, 1924, in Topeka, the daughter of Francis J. and Gladys A. Horne Verschelden. She was educated in Topeka schools, where she graduated from Capitol Catholic High School in 1943 (now Hayden Catholic High School). Luci married her high school sweetheart, Florian "Rennie" Neider on January 8, 1944, in Camp Roberts CA. After WWII they made their home in Topeka. They were members of Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church.

In 1983, Luci and Florian moved to Bella Vista AR. There, they were members of St. Bernard's Catholic Church.
