Mary Susan Muckenthaler, 90, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Monday, April 8, 2024.

Sue was born in Topeka on February 20, 1934, the daughter of Merle and Margaret Quaney Martin. She played basketball and softball during her school years and graduated from Hayden High School in 1952. Following high school she attended Clark's School of Business. Sue married Merwyn Muckenthaler on March 19, 1953, in Assumption Catholic Church; he preceded her in death in 2020. She worked at Southwestern Bell briefly and spent 19 years as a real estate agent. Sue was a founding member of Christ the King Catholic Church and assisted with funeral dinners and Adoration. She was also a member of the Daughters of Isabella. Sue enjoyed reading, basketball with her children and grandchildren, water volleyball at the YMCA, and bowling for many years on Wednesday night league.

Sue is survived by her children, Kathy McCaffrey (Don), Pat Muckenthaler (Roberta), Duane Muckenthaler (Jean), Tim Muckenthaler and Jeff Muckenthaler; daughter-in-law, Pam Muckenthaler; 12 grandchildren; 9 great-grandchildren; and her brother Bill Martin. She was also preceded in death by her son Alan Muckenthaler.
