Mary Margaret Walker, 87, Topeka, passed away Saturday, February 4, 2006.

Mrs. Walker was born August 17, 1918 in Phoenix, Arizona, the daughter of Bert and Anna Basgall Pettijohn. She attended Capital Catholic High and graduated from Hoyt High School. On June 26, 1943, Mary Margaret and Orval Henry Walker were married in Topeka. They owned and operated Economy Sewer Service for many years. Mr. Walker died May 9, 1992. Through the Red Cross' Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Mrs. Walker was "Stuff" of Huff, Puff and Stuff, a musical clown group who entertained at nursing homes for 16 years. She was a member of Holy Name Catholic Church and the Holy Name Altar Guild.
