Melvin Joseph Schreiner, 78, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, February 5, 2018, at his home with his family.

Melvin was born September 14, 1939, the son of Leo and Lidwina Reidel Schreiner. Melvin attended Quincy Elementary and Assumption Catholic Grade School and graduated from Hayden Catholic High School in 1957. Melvin served our country with the Army National Guard for eight years. On October 30, 1965, Melvin and Judith Ann Weibel were united in marriage at Assumption Church in Topeka, enjoying over 52 years together.

Melvin worked for Southwestern Bell Telephone and then AT&T, retiring with 30 years service. He handled the phone service work at Pay-Less Shoes for 25 years and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers. Melvin was a member of Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, Council No. 534 and the James W. Gibbons Fourth Degree Assembly.

Grateful to have shared Melvin's life are his wife, Judi; sons, Todd (Michelle), Troy (Marcy), Tyson (Lindsey) and Travis; seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; sister, Mary Ann Didier; and brothers, Leo, Ben and his twin, Marvin Schreiner. Melvin was preceded in death by his sisters, Clara Schreiner, Leona Perrin, Alvina Konrade and brother, Ray Schreiner.

There will be a Fourth Degree Chalice Ceremony at 6 p.m. Thursday at Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church followed by the rosary led by the Knights of Columbus. Melvin's family will then greet friends until 8:30 at the Church.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at Mother Teresa of Calcutta Church Friday at 10 a.m. Burial will follow at Rochester Cemetery.
