Merle L. Krug, passed away, Sunday, September 30, 2012 at Rolling Hills Health Center. Merle was born in Topeka, KS on July 2, 1935 to Alex and Frances (Hood) Krug. He married Waneta (Jordan) Krug on October 30, 1953. Together they had two sons, Kevin and Richard. At that time he was working at Safeway Grocery in North Topeka, but was taking tests to become a mechanic as he loved working with his hands.
