



## Merlin "Mike" Hogan

Merlin "Mike" John Hogan, 74, passed away Thursday, August 17, 2006 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born July 11, 1932 at Marysville, KS to John P. and Leta J. Breeding Hogan.
