Michael George Bright, Jr. 82, Meriden, Kansas, passed away January 7, 2021.

Mike was born December 21, 1938, in the family home on Seward Avenue in Topeka to Michael and Matilda Marks Bright. He was a 1957 graduate of Hayden High School. Mike served our country in the US Coast Guard from 1956 to 1960 then transitioning into the reserves for two more years. On April 20, 1968, Mike and Shirley Montgomery were united in marriage at Assumption Catholic Church, Topeka, enjoying more than 52 years together.

In the mid-60s, Mike was a member of the Shawnee County Mounted Posse Drill Team under Sheriff Chaffee. He was a horse show announcer during that same time as well and helped start the North Topeka Saddle Club and served on their board.

Mike retired in 2000 from BNSF Railroad Purchasing and Materials Department. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, Council No. 7426. He also was a member of the Swinging Square Dance Club at Croco Square. Known for his "Baby Huey" act for different organizations, Mike had his audience laughing so hard they couldn't breathe. Mike was a member of St. Aloysius Catholic Church in Meriden, Kansas.

Mike is survived by his wife, Shirley; son, Casey Joe Bright; grandchildren, Lindsay Ross (Marvin), Jade Bright, and Winston Bright; great-grandchildren, Nakita "Kita" Ross, Jivonni Ross, Winston Bright, Alexi Bright, and Freya Bright; and many nieces and nephews.
