Michael A. Cameron, 58, Topeka, passed away Sunday, March 21, 2010. Mike was born February 2, 1952, in Topeka, the son of Alan and Alice Lueb Cameron. He was a 1970 graduate of Hayden High School and earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in mass media and print journalism from Washburn University in 1997. Among his various job titles, Mike was a sports copywriter for the Topeka Capital-Journal, was a research analyst for the State Fire Marshall's office, and most recently was a risk communications specialist with the Kansas Dept. of Health and Environment where he was certified with the CDC as a pandemic train/trainer. He was a Boy Scout who earned the Eagle Scout award and was a Master Angler. Mike was member of Mater Dei Parish. Survivors include his mother, Alice Cameron; siblings, Patti Cameron, Tim Cameron (Sandy), Kirby Cameron (Tammy), David Cameron and Libby Hermanson (Jim), all of Topeka; and nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his sister, Anne Cameron Bartron, and his father, Alan Cameron.
