Michael Dean Hager, 69, Topeka, Kansas passed away at St. Francis Hospital on August 24, 2019. He was born in Concordia, Kansas on May 29, 1950, to Adolph and Maxine Hebert Hager. Michael attended schools in Concordia and was a 1968 graduate of Notre Dame High School. He enlisted in the United States Army and served in the Vietnam War. Michael later enlisted in the Army National Guard where he continued his career before retiring as a Sergeant Major after 30-plus years of service to our country.

Michael was a loving dad and grandpa who had his priorities in check. He was a devout Catholic and always willing to give and help others.
