He worked 12 years for Black & Veatch in Overland Park KS and another year in Thailand setting up their communications; he was Director of I.S. for Maximus and had his own I.T. business before becoming the I.S. I.T. Director for KS and TX for Value Options. Anyone who had the privilege of knowing Mike Kadlicek knew how loving and kind he was, his life was all about family and work.
