Michael Ray Paschall, 69, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Thursday, February 24, 2022.

Michael was born on April 3, 1952, in Topeka, the son of Donald and Frances Heckel Paschall. He graduated from Highland Park High School in 1970 and earned his bachelor's degree from Reformed Bible College in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Michael married Debra Nicolay on September 2, 1972, in Topeka. Michael was a pastor for 25 years for the Wesleyan Church, serving in Wisconsin and Michigan, and worked as a sales rep for Proctor and Gamble prior to becoming a pastor. After his retirement from pastoring, he worked for Stormont Vail Hospital as a safety monitor. Michael loved the Chiefs and the KU Jayhawks.

Michael is survived by his wife, Deb; children, Stefanie Hibschan (Tim), Jeff Paschall (Leslie) and Andrew Paschall (Chelsea); grandchildren, SPC William Paschall, James Hibschan, Cole Paschall, Sofie Hibschan, Miles Paschall, Lilly Paschall and Ezra Paschall; and sister Cheryl Falteisek (Duane). He was preceded in death by his parents.
